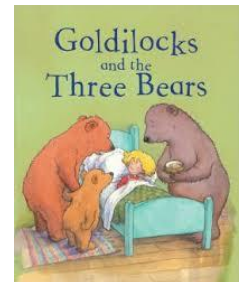
Coffee and cake afternoon

New learning theme

February brings a new learning theme to Little Learners. Its entitled, 'There was a mummy bear, a daddy bear and a baby bear'. Our focus text will be Goldilocks and the three bears and this week we have begun to transform our learning street role play area into the three bears cottage. We will also try our hand at oat cookies and porridge play dough whilst we learn about quantity and capacity.
