New Nursery classrooms building site

Thank you for your continued patience and understanding throughout the duration of the works happening around our Nursery entrance. We are pleased to confirm that the utilities have now been connected to the new site and the usual Nursery entrance will be available to use again from Monday 3rd July.

You will also notice that you will need to take a few more steps before you come across the Nursery gate! It has been necessary to move the gate a few meters further down the fence, as in September this will be opposite the gate to access the new Nursery building.

Collection arrangements

During the period of time that you have been using the school office to collect your Little Learners after lunch, the Nursery Crew have been preparing your Little Learner to be collected by getting them ready with their coat/jacket on and belongings in hand.

As a team, we have noticed this has positively influenced the collection process in a number of ways. Of course many of our Little Learners have younger siblings in pushchairs and whilst we genuinely enjoy seeing them, the welcome area of our classroom becomes quite overcrowded if too many arrive at once. It also certainly relieves congestion in the cloakroom area and allows the children to be calmly waiting and ready to tell you about their busy Nursery session when you arrive. Lastly, it ensures the collection process is efficient and allows our Nursery Crew to be ready to receive the children arriving for their afternoon session.

Using our usual Nursery entrance, we will be continuing to help get the children ready to be collected and asking parents to wait outside until a member of staff is ready to handover to you and ensure your Little Learner meets you safely. This does mean we will adhere more closely to our collection and drop off times as specified below.

Morning session collection - 12.45pm-1.00pm

Afternoon session drop off - 1.00pm-1.15pm
