Christmas Nativities

It has come around so quickly! Please be assured that whilst the children are making tickets for the event, this is a literacy based task to help provide them with opportunities to write for a purpose. Tickets are not required for entry on either day.



For both performances and all children, we ask that children arrive already dressed in their costumes.

In addition, for those children who aren't already at Nursery it would be really helpful for us just one adult pops them into Nursery before the performance. We are expecting almost 25 children to arrive at the same time and you can appreciate we would like to reduce congestion where possible.

Tuesday 6th December

Please bring your child to the Nursery entrance at 9.45am, then walk to the main school entrance where you will be asked to sign in and shown to the school hall for the performance at 10.00am.

Wednesday 7th December

Please bring your child to the Nursery entrance at 2.00pm, then walk to the main school entrance where you will be asked to sign in and shown to the school hall for the performance at 2.15pm.

After each performance we fully expect each Little Learner to want to spend a little time with their loved ones hearing how well they did up on stage.

If your Little Learner does not usually attend on this day please remember to sign them out as you leave.

If your Little Learner will be continuing their Nursery session as usual, please hand them over to a member of Nursery Crew to ensure we are aware of when you are leaving.

Finally, we have been practicing lots and we really hope our Little Learners are going to enjoy being on stage as much as you will enjoy watching them. If there are any children who become particularly anxious or upset at all, as parents please do make yourself known to a member of staff. We welcome children to sit with their parents for the performance if they are feeling uncomfortable on stage.

Suitable group photos will be posted on the Little Learners and school social media pages. Your cooperation is much appreciated.
